



## New Features in Lords of the Realm for CD-ROM

**Map of Germany:** You can now choose to play Lords of the Realm on a map of either England or Germany. Choose from the options that appear when you start the game.

**Enhanced Animations:** The animated scenes have been enhanced and expanded. The rate at which the animations will run depends on your machine's speed and capabilities.

**Digitized Speech:** Many messages in the game are now spoken as they appear on the screen. This option is available for all sound cards which can play digital sound effects, such as the Sound Blaster series, and is automatically configured when the other sound card settings are chosen.

**Multiplayer Mode:** When a human player is eliminated from the game, he must end his turn after being notified of his elimination to allow the next player to take his turn. Also, detailed army battles are now supported in multiplayer games; the mouse can be used to control both armies at any time. You can now receive regular reports of your progress through the Status Flags screen during a multiplayer game; the appearance and timing of this screen is controlled in the same fashion as the Steward's Report in a single-player game.

**Army Movement:** An army that has already moved during a turn will now be displayed with a still flag instead of a waving one. An army that has not yet been moved will flash on the Overview map.

## Installation

*Note: The instructions provided in the Technical Support and Tutorial booklet packaged with your game are designed for use with 3.5" floppies, not this CD-ROM version of Lords of the Realm. Although the instructions are similar, you should follow the steps below to install your CD game and **not** the ones in the booklet.*

This game **cannot** be run from the CD-ROM — it must be installed to your computer's hard disk. *Lords of the Realm* will occupy about 2.5 megabytes of space when fully installed. Each game you save will take up an additional 170 K of room.

- A) Before starting to install the game, make sure that your computer is turned on and that the MS-DOS prompt is showing. The prompt should look like this: C:\>. (The letter may be different if you are in a different drive.) Exit completely out of any other programs you may have running, such as Windows or Dosshell.
- B) Insert the compact disc into your disc drive and change to that drive. Do this by typing the letter designation of your disc drive, followed by a colon, followed by Enter. For example, if your disc drive is your "D" drive, you would type **D:** then press the <ENTER> key.
- C) Type **INSTALL** at the CD-ROM drive prompt and press <Enter>. Detailed directions for installing the game software will appear on the screen. When you have finished reading them, press <Enter> to continue with the installation. At any time during the process you may press <Escape> to abort the installation.



- D) By default, the installation program will create a directory on your main drive called **LORDSCD** and place all the game files in that directory. If you want to install the game to some other directory, delete the default directory name when the screen appears and type in the new directory. For example, if you already have a directory called *GAMES*, and you want to create a subdirectory for *Lords of the Realm* called *LORDSCD*, you would delete the default name and type **C:\GAMES\LORDSCD** instead.
- E) When the installation program is complete, the **Sound Card Setup** screens will appear automatically. Please refer to the *Technical Supplement and Tutorial* booklet for instructions on setting up the game sound and loading the game for play. **Do Not** try to run *LORDS-CD* from the CD-ROM drive -- only from your hard drive.
- F) **Important Sound Note:** If you wish to reconfigure your sound by running *setup.exe*, be sure that the game disc is in your CD-ROM drive before you run the setup program.
